

The Layout

Central to exploration in the *Contexticon* are two powerful functions – the “Tours” and the “Term Exhibits” (see right). Used together, these enable you to hear biblical term usage more as early audiences would have heard it.

Working with the Tour/Exhibit functions might be compared to entering a museum: Guides (in our case the “Tours”) offer you informed perspective on the featured exhibits. Then one is encouraged to see firsthand the display rooms with their exemplary treasures (what we call “Exhibits”), gaining direct insight and perspective.

In addition to the Tours/Exhibits functions, you will also see topical tabs – located in vertical columns at the far left and far right margins of the screen. These tabs play a support role for Tours. They give you quick answers to questions that arise as your journeys proceed. But remember: the tabs are *ancillary support functions*; they are not meant to divert you from the main tours!
